

**BEMSQUEST001 CQHHS BEMS Take Five Questionnaire**

Can I; Work Crew Members; Staff; or Public:

- Fall to a lower level
- Be struck by falling objects
- Be caught in; by; on or between anything
- Injure others by your activities
- Be injured by other activities
- Be injured by contact with an energy source (e.g. electricity)
- Be injured by Stored energy
- Be injured by Over-exertion / over strain / manual handling
- Be injured by Slips, Trips and Falls
- Be injured by Spills, Pollution, Dust
- Be injured by Weather / time of day work to be performed
- Be injured by Uncontrolled movements of traffic or people
- Be injured by Inhaling, swallowing or contact with chemicals
- Be injured by Exposure to asbestos
- Be injured by Exposure to noise
- Be injured by Exposure to biological hazards / infection control
- Be injured by Exposure to radiation
- Will work interrupt clinical procedures?

Answering ‘Yes’ to any items above requires a Take Five to be completed to:

- a) Determine controls to be put in place and rate Residual Risk (RR); and or
- b) Complete the required work permit(s) or notification and or
- c) Complete / review Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS)

**NOTE:** If the Residual Risk (RR) rate cannot be reduced to ‘Low’ a General Work Permit is required.

Hierarchy of Hazard Controls (in order of preference)

- a) Eliminate: Complete removal of hazard
- b) Re-design: Can the process be modified?
- c) Substitute: Less hazardous process, method or substance
- d) Engineering: Isolation, barriers, guards or covers
- e) Administrative: Procedure, permits, signs etc.
- f) PPE: Use Personal Protective Equipment
